Pot still. A rare gin that has been aged in used, lightly charred oak barrels for 6 months. Pewter/tarnished silver hue; excellent purity. First sniffs detect bramble-like, woody aromas of moss, earth, drying leaves, and anise; following another six minutes in the glass, the bouquet at last introduces juniper to the mix as well as flax seed and crushed violets. Entry is grassy, medium oily, and nicely juniper/piney/sappy tasting; midpalate is delicate, smooth, rich, and deep on foresty/woody botanicals, then in the finish the taste turns peppery and bittersweet.
